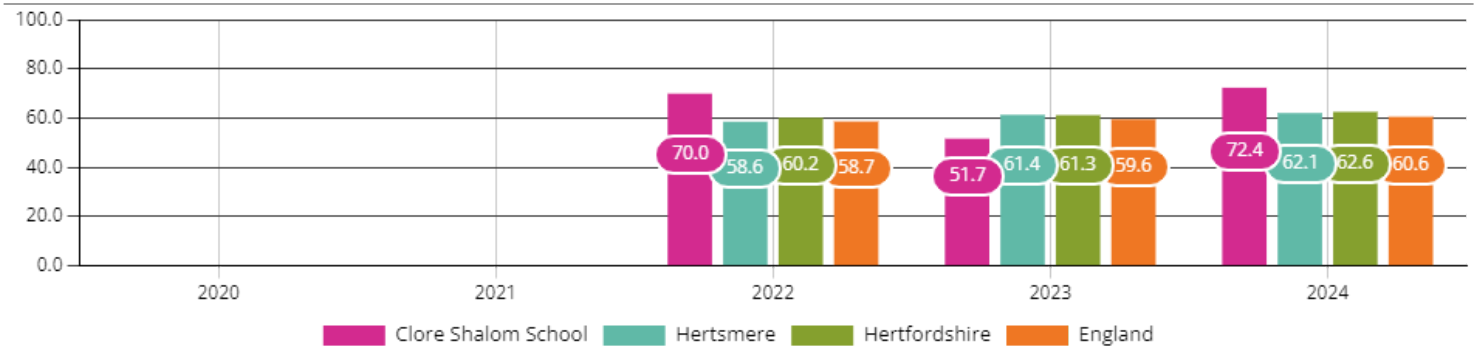

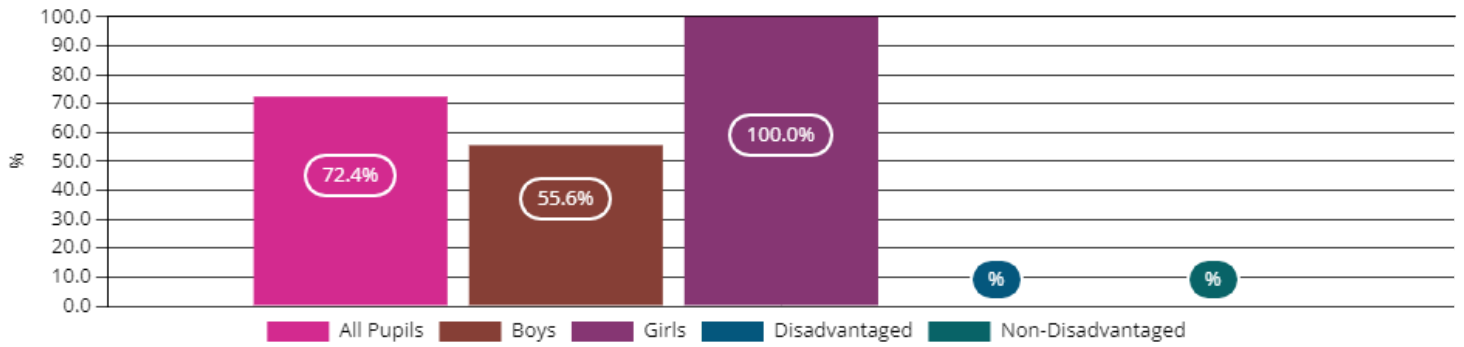

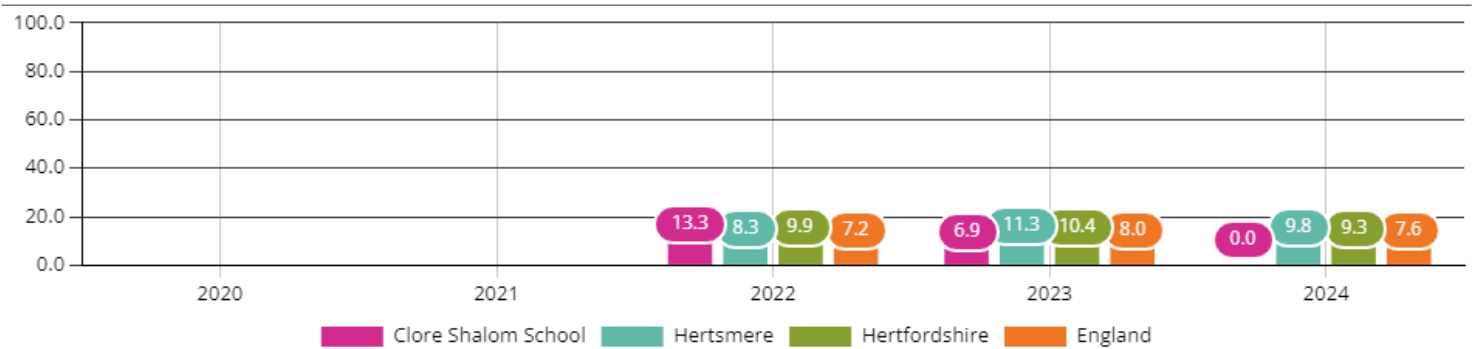

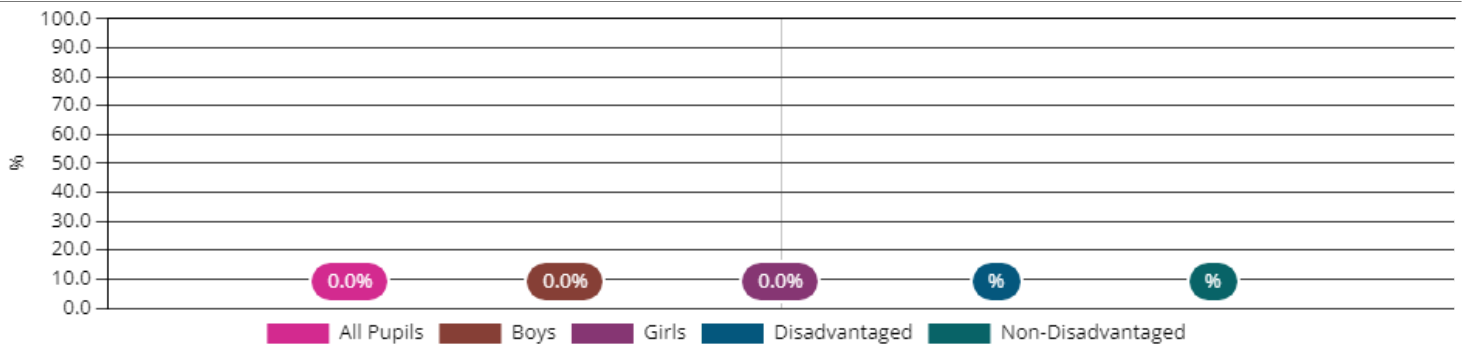

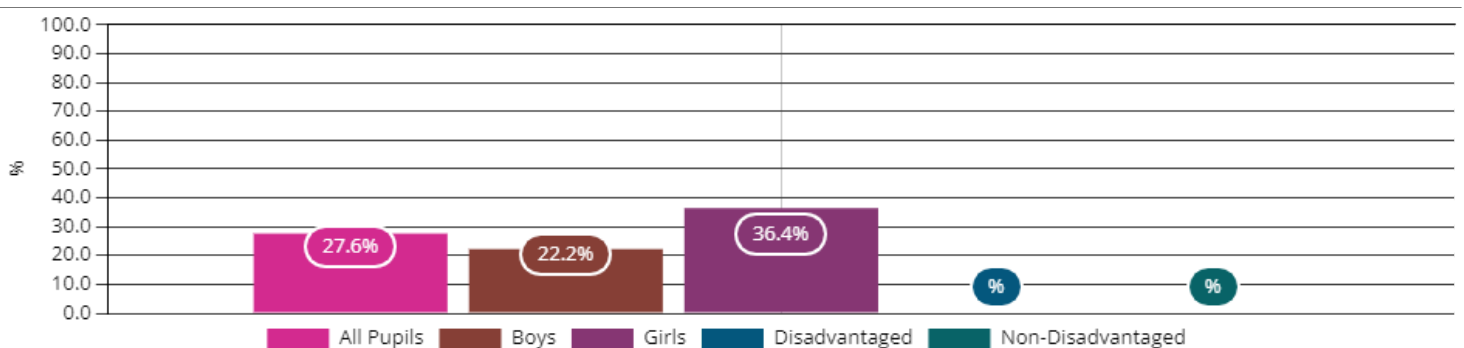

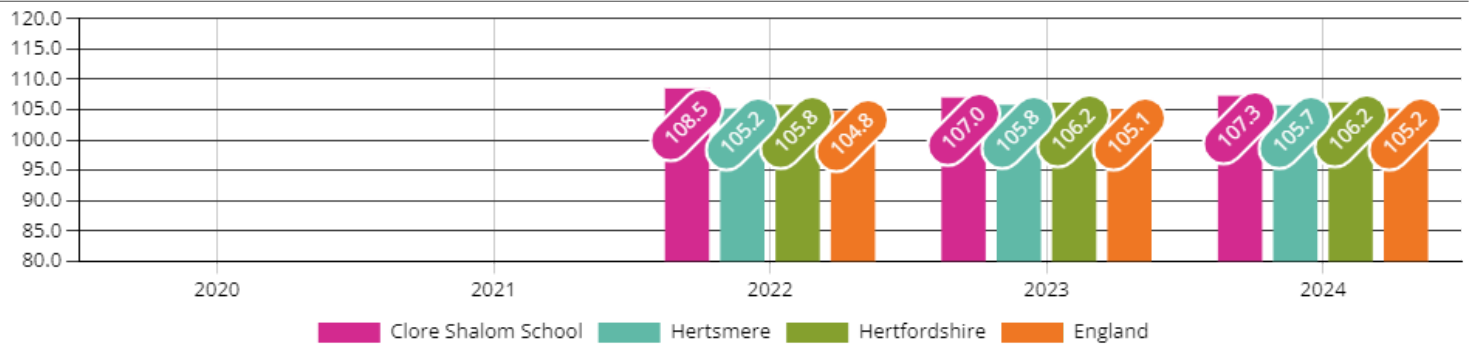
Comparison of pupils working at a higher standard of reading at Clore Shalom School for 2024

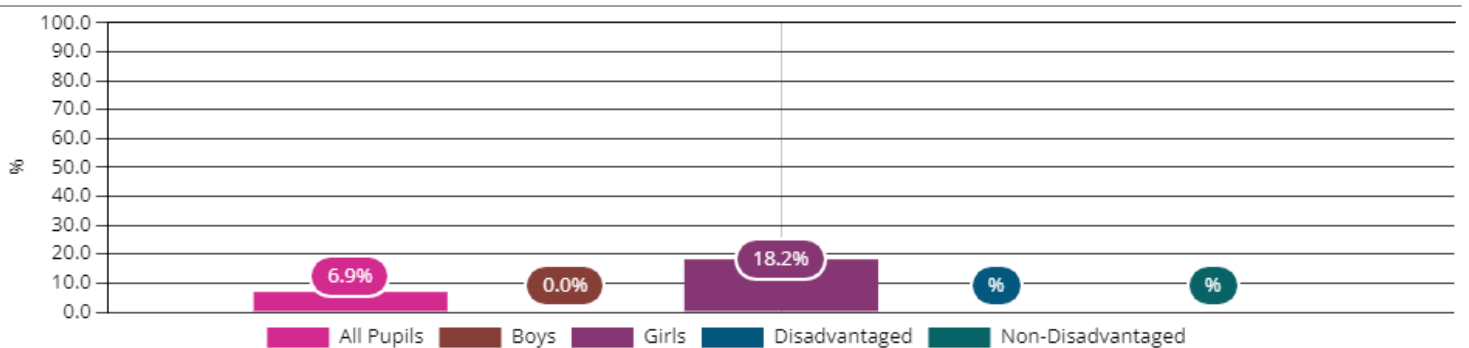

## Percentage of Pupils Working at or Above the Maths Standard

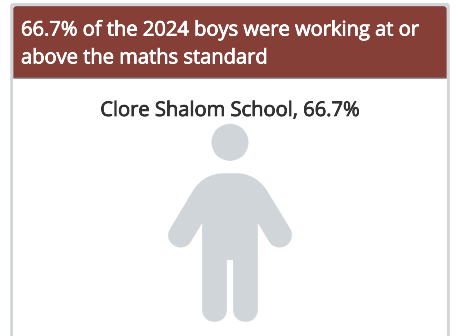

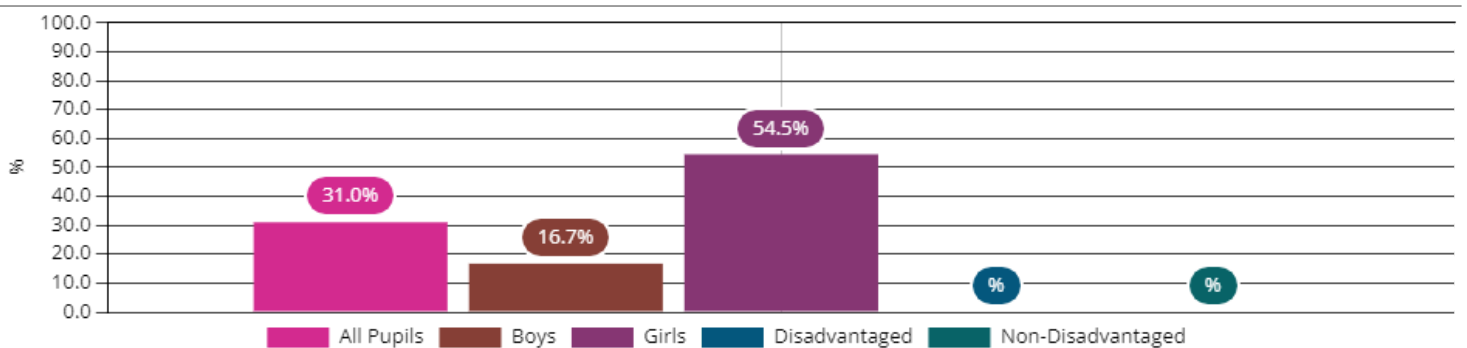

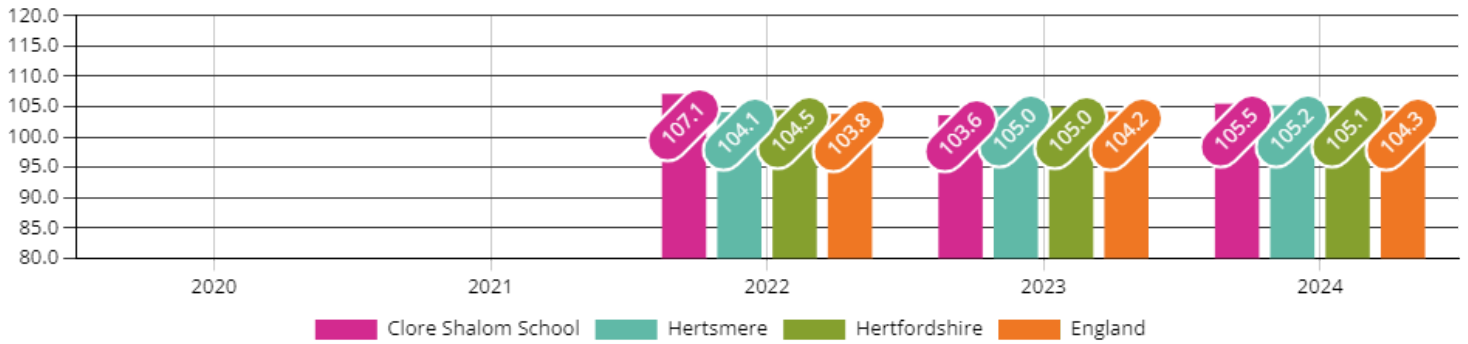
Comparison of pupils working at a higher standard in maths at Clore Shalom School for 2024

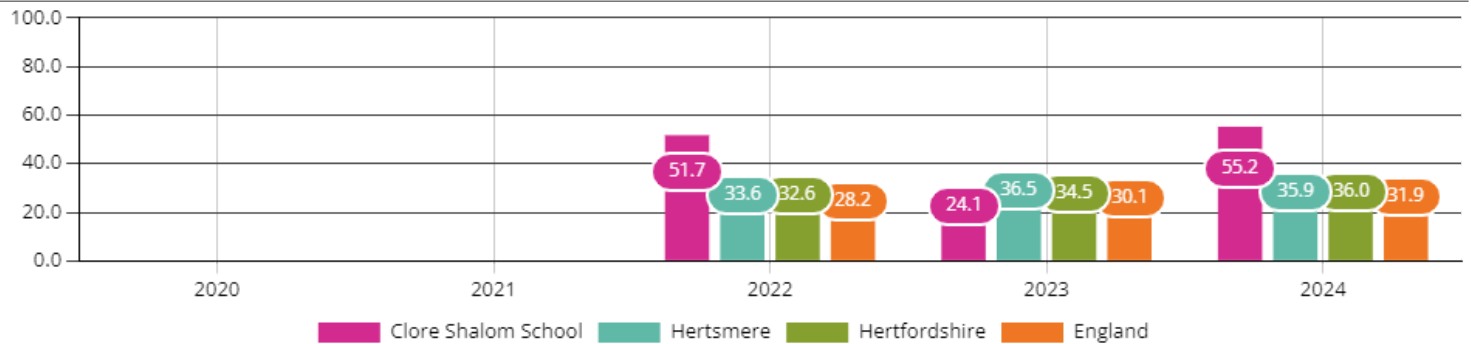

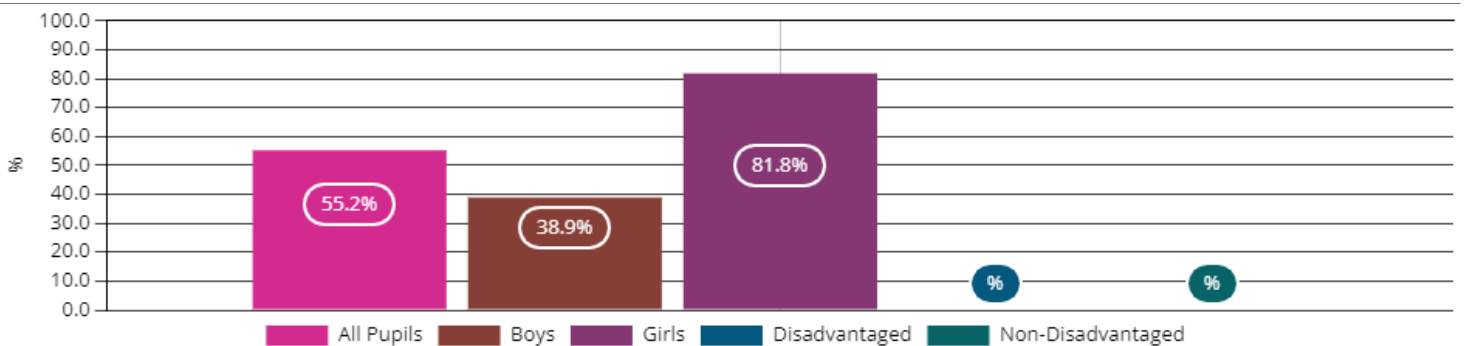

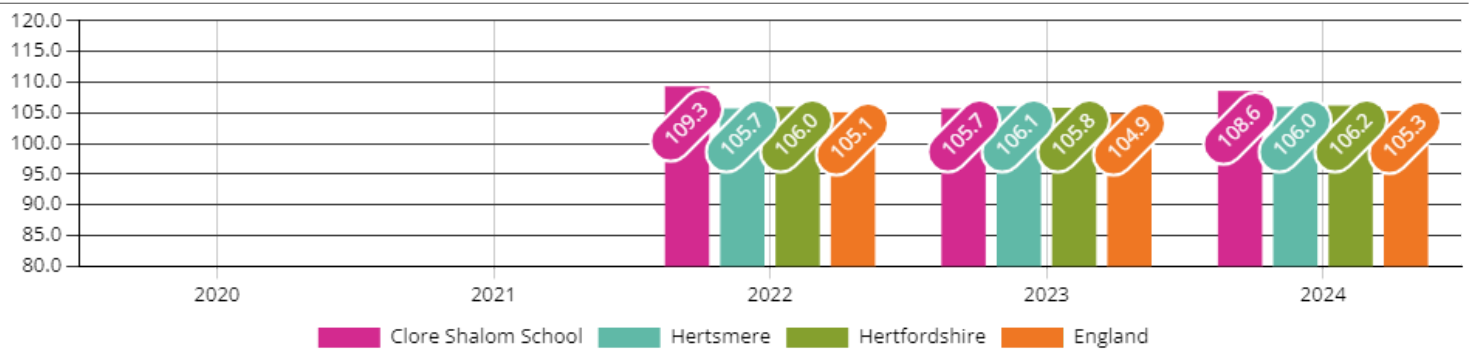
